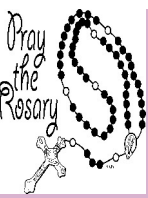

REMEMBER ST. PAUL'S CHURCH
 Endowment Trust, the St. Paul's Holy Family School Endowment Trust and the Cemetery Trust when making out your will or making a bequest. *A change in beneficiary on a Life Insurance or Retirement account is a simple way to include the Parish in your final wishes. Even 5% to the Parish would make a difference in continuing the fine works of our Parish.*

If you are 70.5 years or older, you may be able to give an amount (up to \$100,000) each year from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) directly to the St. Paul's Church, Holy Family School or St. Paul's Cemetery without having to pay taxes on the money. This is a popular form of giving that is sometimes referred to as the IRA charitable rollover, or the qualified charitable distribution (QCD). When you turn 73, this gift may begin counting toward your required minimum distribution (RMD).

To qualify as a tax-free donation, your disbursement must come directly from the administrator of your IRA to the Charity organization. You cannot receive the funds first. Please contact the administrator of your IRA with any tax or account-specific questions.

1. To make a gift from your IRA, please follow these steps: Seek the advice of your financial or legal advisor if necessary.
2. Determine the gift you would like to give.
3. Contact Donna Frank, St. Paul's Parish Administrator at (607) 337-2216 or donnahfs@hotmail.com to inform us of your intended gift including the amount of the gift.
4. Ask your IRA administrator to send a check from your account directly to: St. Paul's Church, 30 Pleasant St. Norwich NY 13815. Please include your name in the memo of the check and note that it is a gift to St. Paul's Church, Holy Family School or St. Paul's Cemetery.



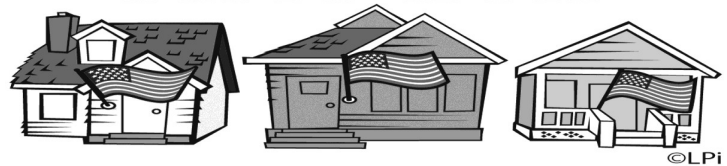
